

Terms and Conditions for Peak Performance Hockey Schools

Rules of conduct

Players must abide by the following rules when attending any of our camps

1. No profanity
2. Participant's must give courtesy and respect to all coaches, staff and student's
3. Change rooms and equipment will be kept neat and tidy
4. There will be no damage to any equipment that belongs to either a fellow student, Peak Performance, or the arena in which the camp is hosted. If there is any damage, you will be billed for replacement and may also be ejected from the camp.
5. When on lunch break, you must notify your instructor of where you are or are going
6. There will be no alcohol or drugs brought into any of our camps for any reason
7. If you have any medical conditions or are taking any medications, please notify your instructor immediately.

Failure to abide by these rules may result in the participant being ejected from the camp. If a participant is ejected NO refund will be given.

By reading this document and agreeing to it in the registration form, you are waiving your right to sue or seek any form of compensation from Peak Performance Hockey School, its owners, sponsors, coaches staff and families for any injuries or mental distress sustained during the operation of our camp or as a result of our camp. Peak Performance Hockey School, its owners, coaches, sponsors and staff are not responsible for the participants personal belongings. Our school is designed for instruction and skills development. If your student cannot put on/ remove their own equipment, or get home and to the camp on their own, a parent or guardian should attend the camp as well.

7 Day Merchandise Guarantee

If you are not completely satisfied with your purchase, we are happy to accept your unused merchandise in its original unopened packaging and in its original condition within 7 days for a credit or exchange. Please note that sale merchandise must be

returned within 7 days of purchase at your expense for shipping. It is understood that the jersey you ordered CAN NOT be exchanged for a different size as we order exactly what you requested. It is understood that the early bird registration is only eligible if payment and form have been received prior to midnight on June 15, 2011. It is understood that a jersey WILL NOT be guaranteed if you register after July 15, 2011. It is understood that we WILL NOT accept cheques after August 1, 2011. If you have not purchased a meal program, you must provide lunch and snacks for the student.

Cancellation/Refund Policy

In the event of a cancellation, a refund will be provided up to 14 days prior to the start of the camp. However, a refund will be subject to a \$100.00 administration fee. After 14 days prior to the camp, no refund will be allowed unless approved by management. The only reason for doing so would be medical reasons and a doctor's note would need to be provided.
